Dr Mishra is heading the Statistical Division and Data Analytics Unit of DGFT, Department of Commerce and is driving the trade analytics and foreign trade intelligence through the management information system (MIS) and statistical activities for promotion, monitoring and evaluation of India's foreign trade.

After 1½ year post-graduate teaching experience in Statistics at Sambalpur University, Dr Mishra joined the Indian Statistical Service (ISS) in April 1993. Since then he has been working in progressively increasing roles and responsibilities, spanning across official statistics, monitoring and evaluation of development programmes, planning and policy issues in various Ministries/Departments of the Government of India. He worked as Capacity Development Advisor in United Nations Development Programme (UNDP), Afghanistan. He played a significant role in setting up of the Unique Identification Authority of India (UIDAI) under the aegis of Planning Commission in 2009. As Director (Rural Development) of the Planning Commission, he spearheaded the rural development programmes such as National Rural Livelihood Mission (NRLM) replacing Swarnjayanti Gram Swarojgar Yojana (SGSY), Special Projects on placement-linked Skill Development Programme, and National Social Assistance Programme (NSAP). While working as a Director (Planning and Coordination) in Ministry of Statistics and Programme Implementation, he was instrumental in drafting the Ministr's Vision 2030 document with a 7 years Strategy and 3 years Action Plan, aligned with the UN's SDG Monitoring Framework.

Dr Mishra graduated from Utkal University, Bhubaneswar in 1986 with First Class First in Statistics Honours and First Class First in Masters in Statistics with University Gold Medals for Best Graduate and Best Post Graduate. He holds an M. Phil degree in Statistics from the University of Delhi and Ph D degree in Statistics from Utkal University, Master's degree in Human Resource Development (HRD) from the University of Manchester, U.K. and Master's degree in Public Administration from the Lee Kuan Yew School of Public Policy, National University of Singapore. He has 11 research and analytical papers published in national and international journals. His research interests include official statistics, monitoring and evaluation, foreign trade statistics, sampling design, data collection, analysis and dissemination, human resource management and development, public policy, poverty and rural development.
